## UNITED STATES GOLF ASSOCIATION AMATEUR STATUS WAIVER OF PRIZE MONEY FORM

The Rules of Amateur Status of the United States Golf Association (USGA) define an Amateur Golfer as "One who plays golf for the challenge it presents, not as a profession and not for financial gain."

Rule 3 (Prizes) of the Rules of Amateur Status prohibits an amateur golfer from "playing for prize money." Those who choose to do so forfeit his/her amateur status.

The Rules of Amateur Status also provide that "an amateur golfer may participate in a golf match, competition or exhibition where prize money or its equivalent is offered, provided that prior to participation he/she waives his/her right to accept prize money in that event."

The USGA makes available this waiver form to assist those who wish to protect their amateur status by waiving their right to accept prize money in advance of a competition. Amateur golfers who wish to do so should sign this sheet and submit it to the USGA, no later than the first day of the competition in which they wish to play. He/She also understands that by signing this waiver form, he/she agrees, as a condition of entry, not to accept any prize money or its equivalent from any competition sponsor or organizer.

Further, any player who has previously forfeited his/her amateur status, but wishes to be considered for reinstatement, may also sign and submit this waiver form to the USGA. His/Her signature will be accepted as an indication that he/she did not violate the Rules by playing in the referenced competition for prize money or its equivalent.
